Schedule for Master's-Level Courses, 2018-19 'A' Cycle

Throughout the schedule that follows, please note the following color-coding scheme:

Red Type = M.Div. Junior Required Courses

Green Type = M.Div. Middler Required Courses

Blue Type = M.Div. Senior Required Courses

Purple Type = Courses Required in a two-year
Master's program/ThM

Black Type = Denominational Courses or
Electives

Also, please note the following important information:

- 1) The schedule is arranged first by semester/term, and then by location. E.g., for Fall 2018, the Due West courses are listed together, then the courses at extension centers, then the Columbia courses. So pay careful attention to the headers that indicate semester/term and location.
- 2) If it has not yet been specified who will teach a certain class, the schedule reads, e.g., "PM 608CO: Pastoral Care and Counseling (TBA)."
- 3) In some cases (especially Saturday courses), dates and times have not yet been set. **We will attend to this as soon as we can make arrangements with our host facilities.**
- 4) Some Erskine College courses may be taken for graduate (Seminary) credit either by registering for a corresponding seminary course or by taking the course as an Independent Study.
- 5) The order of presentation is as follows: Due West Campus (and Extension Sites), Columbia Campus, and Erskine Virtual Campus. Terms presented are (in order), Fall Semester and Spring Semester.
- 6) In all cases where information is missing, it will be added and the schedule will be updated as the information is finalized. **Please check the updated schedule on the web page frequently, and always work with the latest version of the schedule** when you plan your courses.
- 7) The Designation "**Book Ends**" means a class will meet early in the semester for 2-2.5 days of residence work, followed by an online "digital bridge" which will continue until the second 2-2.5 residence period, shortly before the end of the semester.
- 8) The Designation "**Flipped**" means a class will meet approximately every other week. The period between meetings will be devoted to readings, audio and video clips, and other forms of research in preparation for the next, live class meeting. Each syllabus will indicate the dates for the live, in-class meetings.
- 9) Courses offered for one level may be taken at another level with proper registration. A course at the MDiv level may be taken for ThM credit (with additional requirements) and will be so indicated by a 'T' suffix. Such a course also may be taken for DMin credit with a 'D' suffix. A ThM or DMin course taken for MDiv/MA credit will be indicated by an 'M' suffix.
