Primary Focus Areas

Teaching/Discipleship

- Teach regularly in the discipleship ministries of the church
- Train elders and deacons annually
- Lead regular Bible Study for seniors

Shepherding

- Regularly visit the members of our congregation for prayer and encouragement
- Follow up with those in personal crisis, offering prayer and counsel as needed
- Assist the elders in their shepherding responsibilities
- Mentor men within the church in coordination with the Men's Ministry
- Provide regular Scripture-based pastoral care and counseling to individuals, marriages, and families.

Worship and Leadership

- Assist the Senior Pastor in planning and leading corporate worship
- Preach approximately 8 times per year
- Serve as the Vice-Moderator of the Session

- Assist with planning and conducting funeral services
- All other duties as assigned by the Senior Pastor
