We are seeking a pastor with musical gifts and a heart for people, whose ministry focus would be leading our congregation in the areas of worship and outreach/evangelism. This is a full-time ordained position.

As Associate Pastor, you will:

- Spend concentrated, regular time in prayer, reading, and study of the Word.
- Serve with the Sr. Pastor and the Session in the overall shepherding ministry of the church.
- Serve with the staff team and ministry leaders to carry out the vision of the church.
- Share periodically in the preaching (10-12 times/yr) and regularly in the teaching ministry.
- Be actively engaged with members and families as one of their pastors.

Focused ministry responsibilities include:

- Lead and direct the planning, quality, and consistency of the worship ministry of our church.
- Oversee, lead and actively participate in the music ministry of the church.
- Lead and promote an environment of invitation, welcome, and connection including engaging and enrolling new members into the congregation.
- Be actively involved in and lead our congregation in evangelistic outreach in our community.

Qualifications:

- Have an MDiv (or equivalent) degree from an accredited seminary, and be ordained or eligible to be ordained in the Associate Reformed Presbyterian (ARP) Church.
- Have experience leading worship music for a church or campus ministry. Possess sufficient skills and proficiency as an instrumentalist and vocalist, with the demonstrated ability to equip, coordinate, and lead a volunteer music team.
- Have a love for people, a passion for evangelistic outreach, and demonstrated experience in leading others to faith in Christ.
- At least 2-3 years of pastoral (or like) experience is preferred.
